



Frequently Asked Questions for Big Sky Volunteers

1. How do I apply to become a volunteer?

There is no application process. Simply attend an orientation session at your convenience. At orientation we tour the facility, go over the expectations and discuss scheduling.

2. Do I need to sign-up for orientation?

No need, orientations are an open invite.

3. How long does orientation last?

Orientation lasts from 12:30 to 1:00. If you arrive more than 5 minutes late you will not be permitted to enter.

4. What if I cannot attend orientation?

Orientation is mandatory prior to beginning hours at our clinic. Orientations are offered the first Friday of every month, if you are unable to attend the next session, you can always attend a future one.

5. Can I reserve a spot for summer or winter break?

Unfortunately, we don't hold spots for volunteers. Spots are filled on a first come, first serve basis.

6. What is the dress code?

Business casual attire is required for both orientation and for ongoing volunteering time slots.

7. Can I do a single day observation only?
